

EMERGENCY INSTRUCTIONS

Dial 911 or 423-303-4444

Provide your location on campus. Follow the instructions of the call taker.



MEDICAL EMERGENCY

1. Call 911 or 423-303-4444
2. Give location and condition of patient.
3. Stay on the phone with the call taker.
4. Do not attempt to move the patient.
5. Have someone meet emergency personnel.



FIRE EMERGENCY

1. Pull fire alarm.
2. Evacuate the building, closing doors, and windows as you exit if you feel safe to do so.
3. Call 911 from a safe location.



SEVERE WEATHER EMERGENCY

1. Go to the nearest building and seek shelter in the lowest level.
2. Choose a shelter location nearest the center of the building, away from windows and glass.
3. When possible seek shelter in interior rooms without windows.



BOMB THREAT EMERGENCY

1. Call 911 or 423-303-4444
2. If there is an immediate danger evacuate the building.
3. Move as far away as possible from all buildings and place yourself behind a large immovable object.
4. Proceed as instructed by emergency personnel.



ACTIVE SHOOTER EMERGENCY

If you see an active shooter on campus, call 911 from a safe location.

RUN

- Have an escape route in mind.
- Leave belongings behind.
- Follow exit signs that take you away from the threat.

HIDE

- Hide out of the shooter's line of sight.
- Barricade doors or windows if possible.
- Turn off lights. Keep quiet, silence electronics.

FIGHT

- Act with physical aggression and full commitment.
- Incapacitate the shooter.
