 - o Signed copy of 2022 Tax Return
 - o Statement of termination (with dates) from prior employer
 - o Documentation of unemployment benefits
 - o Medical out-of-pocket expenses (1040 Schedule A)
 - Copy of legal documentation proving change in marital status
 - Statement from private school showing tuition costs for the 2022-2023 school year.
