Required documentation to prove change in income:

- A written statement outlining the circumstances regarding change in income.
- Tax information from 2020 (must include one of the following)
 - o Copy of first two pages of 2020 tax return
 - o Entire 2020 tax return transcript
 - O Use of the IRS Data Retrieval Tool on FAFSA
- Supporting documentation to validate the change in income. Possible supporting documents could be:
 - o Signed copy of 2021 Tax Return
 - O Statement of termination (with dates) from prior employer
 - o Documentation of unemployment benefits
 - o Medical out-of-pocket expenses (1040 Schedule A)
 - Copy of legal documentation proving change in marital status
 - o Statement from private school showing tuition costs for the 2021-2022 school year.
