IMMUNIZATION WAIVER FOR RELIGIOUS REASONS

Lee University adheres to the guidelines set forth by the Centers for Disease Control and the Academy for Immunization Practices that relate to childhood and adult immunizations. Lee University also abides by the laws set forth by the state of Tennessee that stipulate which immunizations are required for admission to all schools of higher education in the state of Tennessee.

All new enrollees to Lee University are required to show written proof of having received two vaccinations for measles, mumps, rubella (MMR), as well as written proof of having received two vaccinations for Varicella (chickenpox). Also acceptable is documented proof from a licensed medical provider of Varicella disease or positive titers showing immunity to MMR and Varicella. This documentation is requested prior to registration.

Lee University and the state of Tennessee allow for vaccine exemptions due to religious reasons. However, if an outbreak of a contagious disease should occur on campus, students who have not been vaccinated will be restricted from attending classes or campus events until the outbreak subsides.

Under penalty of perjury, I affirm my request for exemption of these immunizations for religious reasons. (This document must be signed in the presence of a notary.)
