CALL FOR PHOTOGRAPHY SUBMISSIONS: CAPTURING THE PASSION WEEK

Are you a student with a passion for photography? We invite you to participate in a unique campaign that seeks to visually express the profound emotions of Passion Week. Your challenge is to capture six key moments of Jesus' crucifixion and resurrection through real-life photography—portraying the raw feelings of pain and joy that these events represent.

Submission Guidelines:

- Each submission must consist of six original photographs, one for each scene described below.
- The photographs should creatively interpret these moments in modern-day life, conveying the essence of each event.
- Submissions must be full-res images
- Submissions must be portrait, not landscape
- Please provide a brief (2-3 sentences) description for each photo, explaining how it relates to the chosen theme.

THE SIX SCENES TO CAPTURE:

1. Praise

"Hosanna! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord!" (Mark 11:9) Capture the feeling of joy and celebration as Christ entered Jerusalem. Think of moments that reflect heartfelt praise, triumph, and welcoming celebration.

2. Friendship

"I have eagerly desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer." (Luke 22:15) Photograph a moment that represents the intimacy and love between close friends, just as Jesus shared with His disciples at the Last Supper. A shared meal, deep conversation, or a comforting presence could symbolize this theme.

3. Betrayal

"Judas, are you betraying the Son of Man with a kiss?" (Luke 22:48) This photo should depict the heartbreak of broken trust. Consider moments of deception, loss, or disillusionment—situations where someone exchanges something precious for temporary gain.

4. Service

"Now that I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also should wash one another's feet." (John 13:14) Christ humbled Himself to serve others. Capture an act of selfless service, where someone puts another's needs before their own—whether in a small act of kindness or a profound sacrifice.

5. Suffering

"Surely He took up our pain and bore our suffering." (Isaiah 53:4) The crucifixion represents the ultimate expression of suffering, injustice, and sacrifice. Your photo should tell a story of endurance, sorrow, or pain, capturing the weight of hardship and resilience.

6. New Life

"He is not here; He has risen!" (Luke 24:6) Jesus' resurrection brings hope, joy, and renewal. This image should express transformation, victory, and new beginnings—whether through nature, relationships, or personal redemption.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE:

1. Take photos that embody the essence of each scene.
2. Write a short description for each image.
