



## **Professional/Licensure Program Disclosures**

Lee University is providing the following information for prospective students regarding professional programs that lead, or could be perceived to lead, to licensure to comply with national, federal, and state authorization regulations regarding these program areas. The curriculum for programs customarily leading to licensure at Lee University have been designed to meet the licensure/certification requirements in Tennessee as well as preparing students to apply for licensure exams in the State of Tennessee. The licensure boards in each state/territory are responsible for establishing the requirements for licensure/certificate for their state/territory. Students who intend to return or move to any state/US territory other than Tennessee need to review the professional licensure disclosures pertaining to their program and consult with the state/territory professional licensing board. The state/territory professional licensing boards make the ultimate decision as to whether an individual will be eligible to sit for licensure based on the rules and regulations in place at the time the individual submits their application for licensure.

Some state/territory licensing boards require additional requirements beyond education, which may include (but are not limited to): additional post-graduation examinations or experience, application and licensing fees, criminal background checks, reference checks, fingerprint submissions, etc. Continuing education may also be required for maintenance of certification/licensure in each state/US territory. Make sure you understand and review additional requirements prior to enrolling in your program.

State/territory licensing requirements are subject to change and students should monitor these with their respective state or territory that they plan to apply for licensing in. Some states and territories offer full reciprocity for a Tennessee license or certification, while others have additional requirements to hold a certification or license in their state or territory. The university lists professional and licensure programs below with their licensing status for each state/territory if it is known. Students should still contact their respective licensing/certification authority in their state or territory for the most updated information.
